

Blueing bolete - *Gyroporus cyanescens*



Traits: cap convex, up to 12 cm, buff-tan; pores white-yellowish; stem thick, hollow at maturity, up to 12 cm; flesh whitish, rapidly blueing when bruised; spore pale yellow

When: July → Sept.

Where: on well drained soil under broad leafed trees, mostly birch

Note: hardly any confusion possible; variety *violaceotinctus* blueing indigo used for dyeing
