

Blue roundhead - *Stropharia caerulea*

Traits: slimy cap up to 8 cm in diam., turquoise to yellow; stem up to 11 cm high, pale blue above annular discoloration; gills attached to stem, close, brown white becoming purple-brown; purple-brown spore print

Where: decomposer in rich soils, pastures, vacant lots

When: Occasional Sept.-Oct

Notes: similar to other non-edible stropharius; maybe slightly hallucinogenic
