

Grayling

Cantharellula umbonata

Traits: Gray cap up to 5 cm in diam., funnel-like shaped; decurrent forked, tight, white, stained with yellow-red spots; white stem to 8 cm high, fleshy; white spores

When: abundant Aug. → Oct.

Where: on moss, under coniferous

Notes: Inocybes look-alikes, toxics, with non-forked, non-white gills, and brown spores
