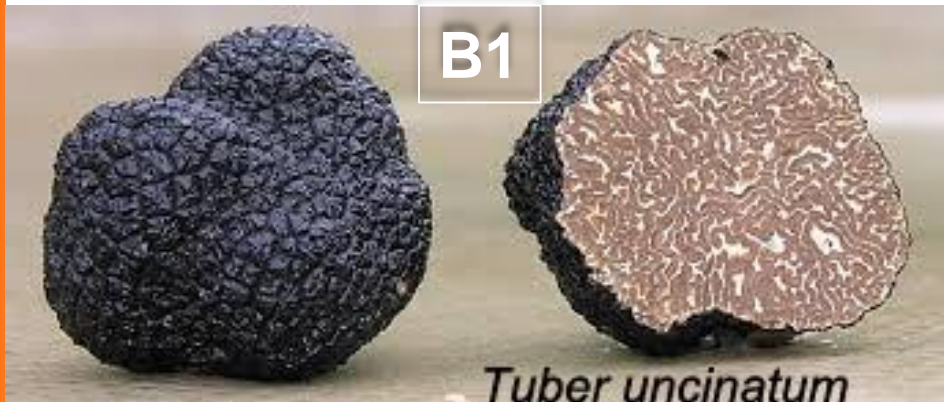


# Burgundy Truffle - *Tuber uncinatum*

**Traits:** Round, irregularly shaped, with black bark (peridium), warty; pale brown to dark flesh (gleba) with white veins, thin and tight; hazelnut smell

**Where:** underground when wild, symbiotic with oak, hazelnut and various other trees in Europe; now cultivated worldwide

**When:** Summer truffle (*T. aestivum*) Autumn variety



**Notes:** Perigord truffle look-alike (*T. melanosporum*), but with more protruding warts; to be eaten raw or lightly cooked
