

Phoenix Oyster

Pleurotus pulmonarius

Traits: lung-shaped cap, up to 10cm in diam., white toward beige; white gills, tight, descending; excentric stem, up to 4 cm long, velvety; white firm flesh; cream colored spores

When: widespread July – Sept.

Where: on deciduous trees, notably beech

Note: very similar to oyster pleurotus, but fruiting in warmer temperature
