

Boletus subglabripes *Hemileccinum subglabripes*

Traits: Cap up to 10 cm in diam., yellow brown, glabrous, fading over time; small yellow olivaceous pores, browning with rustling; foot to 10 cm high, yellow blushing, firm; pale yellow flesh; lemony flavor; spotted olive brown

When: Abundant all over eastern N.A., July → Sept.

Where: Symbiotic mostly with poplar, beech, aspen
