

Two-colored Bolete

Baorangia bicolor

Traits: Cap up to 15cm in diam., red or pinkish yellow, velvety; flesh and pores pale yellow to olive; Club-shaped thick solid stem, yellow; slowly staining blue; Olive-brown spores;
Curry scented



When: occasional, mid-June → mid-Sept.

Where: symbiotic with oak, beech, hickory

Note: similar to *Boletus sensibilis* and *Hortiboletus rubellus*, not recommended
