

# White Amanitas *A. magnivelaris*, *A. bisporigera*, *A. decipiens*, *A. virosa*, *A. phalloides* (Europe)

**Traits:** Completely white; bare cap, up to 10 cm wide; stipe up to 15 cm high, with volva and subtle ring; free gills, tight, uneven; white spores

**When:** common July → Oct.

**Where:** in mixed forest, symbiotic with hickory, oak, beech, linden tree



**Note:** 90 % of lethal intoxications due to amatoxins in these amanitas and a few other species
