

Garlic Marasmius

Mycetinis scorodoni

Traits: cap up to 1 cm wide, convex, rippled, withish; gills adnate, tight; stipe up to 7 cm high, narrowing near base, brown-reddish, paler near cap; white spores; intensely garlicky

When: Occasional June → Sept.

Where: On coniferous litter

Note: Look-alike Pinwheel

Marasmius (*Marasmius rotula*),
non edible and odorless
