

Winter chanterelle *Craterellus tubaeformis*

Traits: cap up to 7cm wide, yellow to dark brown; stem up to 10 cm high, hollow, orange; ridges decurrent, forked; cream colored spores; delicate

When: abundant grouped July → Oct. (dec. on Pacific Coast)

Where: symbiotic with coniferous of humid woodlands

Risk: other small edible chanterelles (*craterellus*); same as yellow chanterelles
