

Yellow morel *Morchella esculenta*

Description: cap: up to 17 cm high and 7 cm wide, hollow, round, or conical, irregularly honeycombed, white to yellow; whitish stalk up to 15cm high; orange spores



Where : occasional under dead elms, in orchards

When : Occasional May → June

Risks: confusion with toxic gyromitra; cook well

Comments: common name that covers at least 5 North American and as many European species
