

Grayling Mushroom *Cantharellula umbonata* B3

Traits: cap up to 5cm wide, convex becoming funnel-shaped; gills decurrent, forked, crowded, white staining yellow-red; stem white up to 8cm high; white spores



When: abundant Aug. → Sept.

Where: on moss, pine needles through out north eastern N.A.

Risk: confusion with toxic species of *Inocybe*, having non forked, non white gills, and brown spores
